## Who is SecurityScorecard?

USLI has partnered with SecurityScorecard as a loss control tool to assist our insureds with cybersecurity risk management. SecurityScorecard non-intrusively collects data from across the internet for an objective, outside-in perspective of the cybersecurity posture of organizations.

## When does USLI run a scan?

Both new business and renewal underwriters use it as a tool to consider a risk for new business terms. Once this risk is bound, it is monitored continuously for changes in the score.

## What should I do if I receive an email alert that one of my policies has a score change?

USLI will only communicate with our customer on the account. Our customer should communicate the findings to the retail agent or with the insured directly. This communication should encourage the insured to explore the details and recommendations of the alert, as well as any other findings by SecurityScorecard. The insured may work with SecurityScorecard directly for assistance in remediating issues.

## What happens if we ignore the alert provided?

It is not recommended to ignore the alert. Consequences for not taking cyber risk management action could result in debits upon renewal, non-renewal or worse – a data breach!
